CHEMICALS

Includes:

- Nail polish/remover
- Aerosol cans
- · Chlorine granules or powder
- Cleaning agents







COMBUSTIBLES

Includes:

- Gasoline
- Charcoal
- Matches
- Ammunition
- All other combustibles









Includes:

- · Propane or oxygen tanks
- Fire extinguishers
- · Any other pressurized gas







PERISHABLES AND PLANTS

Includes:

- · Frozen or opened food items
- Medications
- Houseplants
- · Any other perishables







VALUABLES

Includes:

- · Wills and important documents
- Stocks
- Cash
- Jewelry
- Any other valuables
